PUMPKIN CARVING TIPS

SUGGESTED TOOLS:



- A pumpkin carving kit is much safer than kitchen knives.
- Printer, paper and tape.
- Optional hand mixer for step 1 below.



MAKE SURE YOUR PARENTS ARE NEARBY TO ASSIST!

Clean out your pumpkin – Before grabbing a scoop, consider using a hand mixer to loosen the seeds and stringy stuff!



Print, crumple, and tape – It will be easier to wrap and tape the stencil onto the curve of your pumpkin if you crumple and then smooth out the page.



Use a poker tool to transfer your art – The stencils are made of dotted lines. Poke on each dot to transfer your art!



4. Cut along the dotted lines – Use the tool that's best suited to cut out each shape. Be sure to cut the smaller shapes first and avoid putting pressure on areas that have already been carved.

Tip: If you cut out an area by accident, stick a toothpick through the flesh side of the piece and fit it back into place.

Light up and put on display! – Have your parents help you to safely light up your jack-o'-lantern with a candle. Better yet, use a fire-safe LED pumpkin light.
